
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


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Editor's Note

























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


Photography is an art that requires technical understanding, creativity, and constant learning. Whether you are a beginner or a seasoned photographer, understanding photography jargon is crucial to mastering the craft. This glossary covers essential photography terms from A to C, helping you grasp key concepts and improve your photography skills.

A

Aperture Aperture refers to the opening in a lens through which light enters the camera. It is measured in f-stops (e.g., f/2.8, f/16). A larger aperture (e.g., f/2.8) lets in more light, creating a shallow depth of field and a blurred background. Conversely, a smaller aperture (e.g., f/16) increases depth of field, keeping more of the image in focus.





Aspect Ratio The aspect ratio is the proportional relationship between the width and height of an image. Common aspect ratios include 4:3, 3:2, and 16:9. Choosing the right aspect ratio can enhance the composition of your photographs.



Autofocus (AF) Autofocus is a camera feature that automatically adjusts the lens to ensure the subject is sharp. Different AF modes include Single AF (for still subjects) and Continuous AF (for moving subjects).

Available Light Available light refers to the natural or artificial light already present in a scene, without adding flash or external lighting. It is often used in candid and documentary photography.

Artifact Artifacts are distortions or unwanted elements in digital images caused by compression or post-processing. Examples include banding, pixelation, and halos.



Bokeh Bokeh describes the aesthetic quality of the out-offocus areas in a photograph. It is influenced by the lens and aperture shape. Photographers often use bokeh to create visually appealing backgrounds.


Bracketing Bracketing involves taking several shots of the same scene at different settings, such as exposure levels, to ensure the best result. It's commonly used in HDR photography.

Burst Mode Burst mode allows photographers to take multiple photos in rapid succession by holding down the shutter button. It's ideal for capturing fast-moving subjects.

Bulb Mode Bulb mode is a camera setting that keeps the shutter open as long as the shutter button is held down. It is often used for long-exposure photography, such as capturing light trails or astrophotography.



Backlight Backlight occurs when the primary light source is behind the subject, often creating silhouettes or halos. It can add drama and depth to your photos.



C

Composition Composition refers to the arrangement of elements within a photograph. Strong composition uses principles like the rule of thirds, leading lines, and framing to guide the viewer's eye.

Crop Factor Crop factor is the ratio of a camera sensor's size to a full-frame sensor. It affects the effective focal length of lenses. For example, a crop factor of 1.5x makes a 50mm lens behave like a 75mm lens.




Contrast Contrast refers to the difference between the light and dark areas of an image. High contrast creates dramatic, vivid images, while low contrast results in softer, muted tones.



Chromatic Aberration Chromatic aberration is a color fringing effect caused by lenses failing to focus all colors onto the same point. It is more noticeable in high-contrast areas of an image.

Continuous Lighting Continuous lighting refers to constant light sources, such as LED panels, as opposed to strobes or flashes. It is often used in video production and studio photography.

Mumbai Design Xpress (MDX '24): A Celebration of Colour and Creativity

Pantone's Mocha Mousse debuted in India at the third edition of Mumbai's very own Design Festival - the Mumbai Design Xpress a.k.a MDX '24, where Mumbai's design community celebrated colour's transformative power through panel discussions, workshops, and performances. A report by Vimal Parmar.



On 19 December 2024, Mumbai's design community gathered for the Mumbai Design Xpress (MDX '24), an event that celebrated innovation, creativity, and the transformative power of colour in design. The event was organised by the Mumbai chapter of the Association of Designers of India (ADI).

A highlight of the event was the exclusive launch celebration of Pantone's Colour of the Year, marking the first time this global announcement had been celebrated in India. Elley Cheng, President of Pantone, unveiled the chosen hue, PANTONE 17-1230 Mocha Mousse, a warm brown hue.

The event featured thought-provoking sessions with industry leaders:

Animation in Colour: India and the West

Suresh Eriyat, founder of Studio Eeksaurus, explored the role of colour in Indian animation and its contrasts with

Western styles. He was joined by Gerald Conn, a UK-based animator and BAFTA winner, known for his innovative sand animation. The session was moderated by Suresh Venkat, a seasoned editorial consultant and media trainer.

Nuances of Colour in Design and Culture

A panel discussion, led by Pritha Thadani, founder of Please See, included:

Ashwini Deshpande, co-founder of Elephant Design Studio, who discussed colour's cultural significance in Indian design.

Navdeep Kaur, founder of The Colour Workshop, who spoke about the application of colour research in modern design.

Ayesha Parikh, founder of Art and Charlie, who discussed colour's influence on urban aesthetics.

Elley Cheng, who highlighted colour's role across design mediums.

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


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


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
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
